



- A) Plain cardstock 4 1/4" x 11"
- B) Background paper to coordinate with main color (B1) $2 \frac{1}{4}$ " x 4"; (B2) $1 \frac{7}{8}$ x 4"; (B3) $\frac{3}{4}$ x 4"
- C) Patterned or plain paper (C1) 2" x 3 $\frac{3}{4}$ "; (C2)1 $\frac{5}{8}$ x 3 $\frac{3}{4}$ "; (C3) $\frac{1}{2}$ x 3 $\frac{3}{4}$ "
- D) Plain paper or velum 4" x 4"







B) 2 pieces of 5" x 7" patterned cardstock

Minimum of 2" round hole punch 1 piece, 2" long decorative lightweight string or thin ribbon

Pacific Scribes Supplies for Card Making Community Gathering 9.21.25

- Scissors
- Glue
- · Double-sided tape
- Pencil and eraser
- Ruler
- · Something to score with
- Paper cutter (optional, but handy)

Optional but useful:

- Bone folder
- Round hole punch 2 to 2.5 inches is ideal, but bring the largest size you have if you don't have the ideal size
- Die-cut item for decoration Should be no smaller than 2.75 x 2 and no larger than 3.25 x 2.75
