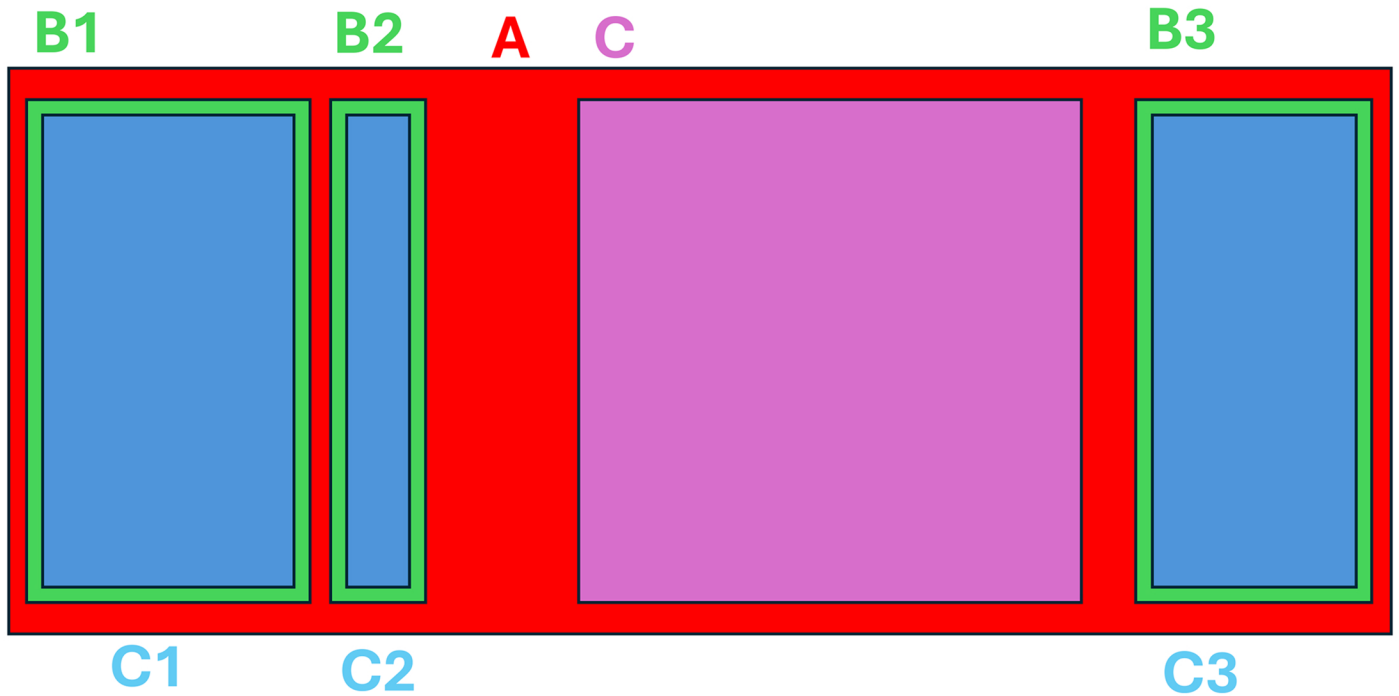
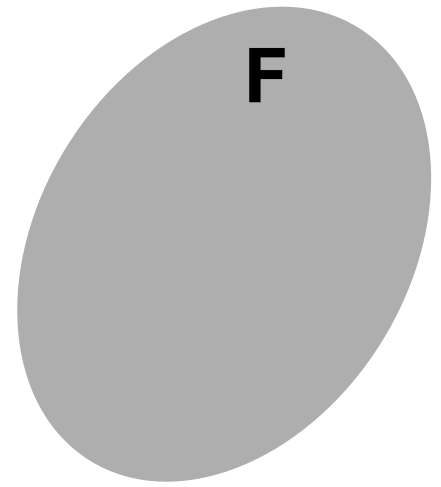


Folded card from Judith Hovde

- A) Plain cardstock - 4 ¼" x 11"
- B) Background paper – to coordinate with main color - (B1) 2 ¼" x 4"; (B2) 1 7/8 x 4"; (B3) ¾ x 4"
- C) Patterned or plain paper (C1) 2" x 3 ¾"; (C2) 1 5/8 x 3 ¾"; (C3) ½ x 3 ¾"
- D) Plain paper or velum - 4" x 4"



- A) 1 piece of plain cardstock – 7 ¼” x 5 ¼”
- B) 1 piece of cardstock – 5” x 7”
- C) 4 pieces of plain cardstock – 6” x 2 ¼”
- D) 4 pieces of plain or pattern paper – 2 ½” x 2”
- E) 1 piece of cardstock – 1” x 3”
- F) 1 cardstock die cut. A square, circle or oval will also work. Should be no smaller than 2 ¾ x 2; no bigger than 3 ¼ x 2 ¾

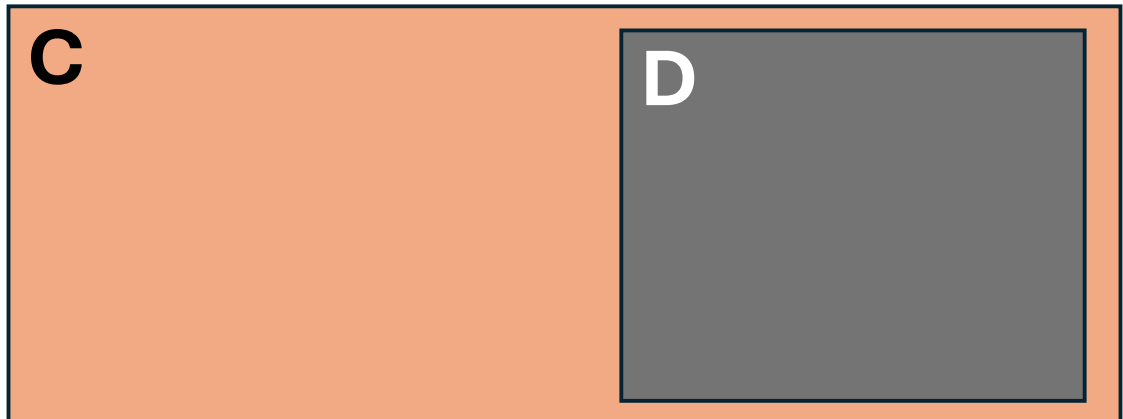

Minimum of 2" round hole punch

1 piece, 2" long decorative lightweight string or thin ribbon

Supplies for Card Making Community Gathering

- Scissors
- Glue
- Double-sided tape
- Pencil and eraser
- Ruler
- Something to score with
- Paper cutter (optional, but handy)

Optional but useful:

- Bone folder
- Round hole punch - 2 to 2.5 inches is ideal, but bring the largest size you have if you don't have the ideal size
- Die-cut item for decoration - Should be no smaller than 2.75 x 2 and no larger than 3.25 x 2.75
